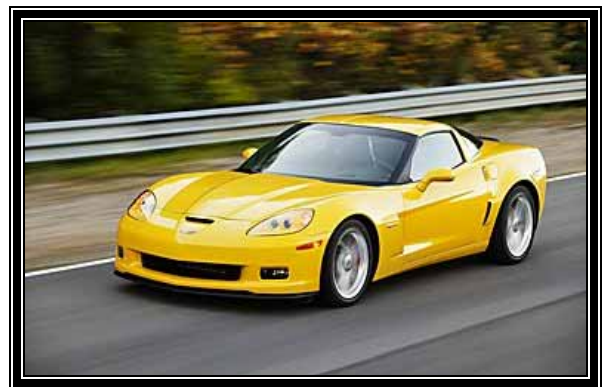

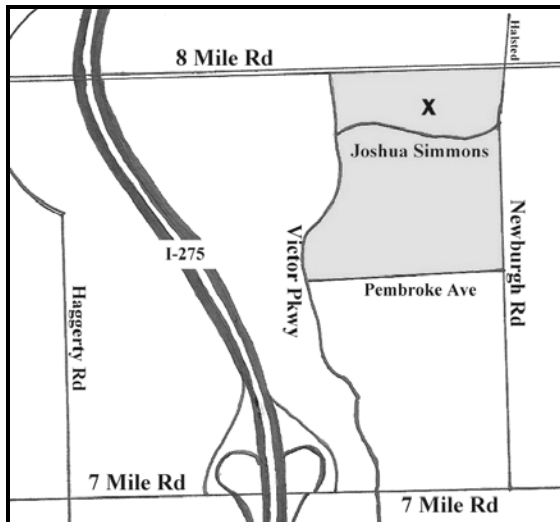

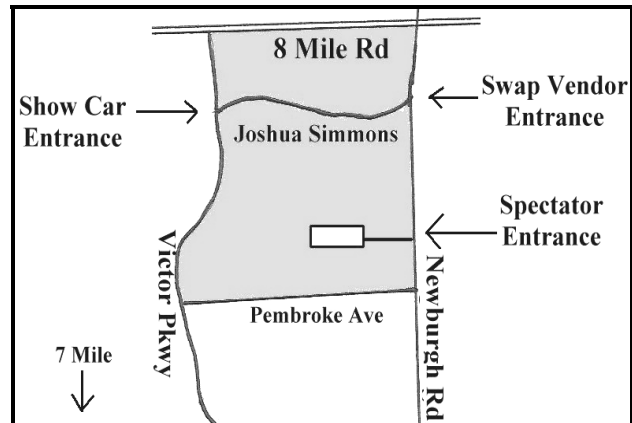

As many of you are aware from discussions at the club meeting, MOCSEM will no longer have our traditional Woodward Dream Cruise location at Whitbeck's Appliance in Ferndale. Whitbeck's has moved to a new location and the property on Woodward is up for sale. The location has served the club well for many years and we are thankful to Whitbeck's for the past use.

New for this year, MOCSEM has made arrangements to park as a group at Mustang Alley which is located on 9 Mile just west of Woodward in downtown Ferndale. Mustang Alley typically attracts between 350 and 400 Mustangs and is a natural place for us to be. There are numerous Ford-sponsored activities during the day with raffles, memorabilia for sale, and food vendors. Cruisers will be able to come and go from Mustang Alley during the day by showing a registration card that is given out during initial check-in.
